GANIL COMMUNITY MEETING 2022

FIRST CIRCULAR

The second GANIL Community Meeting will be held from October the 17th to the 21th 2022 near the marina, in the city center of Caen (France).

The purpose of the meeting is to bring together the whole GANIL community to discuss and define coherently the future research programs for GANIL for the next 3 years. Several presentations will be organized to debate both the intended experimental and theoretical programs related to GANIL covering the main topics of nuclear structure, nuclear dynamic, fundamental interaction, nuclear astrophysics, atomic and interdisciplinary researches and accelerator developments.

An overview of the status of the infrastructures (accelerators, spectrometers and instrumentation) will also be given.

A series of presentations will be organized in specific sessions:

- FAIR Data production and analysis
- Cyclotron complex nuclear physics program and developments
- Theory research program
- Interdisciplinary research program
- S3 physics program
- NFS physics program
- Accelerator developments for SPIRAL2
- The DESIR prospective

Together with the GANIL User Executive Committee (GUEC), these will serve to trigger discussion to establish GANIL's experimental program, the related theoretical research and the corresponding calls for proposals.

A poster session will be also organized.
